Notice to Shareholders

June 8, 2023

Campfire ban:

With forest fire season ,campfires are now banned in Cedars RV Resort until Oct. 13 2023. This follows a fire ban issued by BC Wildfire Service for Kamloops Fire Centre. Prohibition includes :

Category 1 campfires as defined in the Wildfire Regulation;

- Category 2 open fire as defined in the Wildfire Regulation; and,
- Category 3 open fire as defined in the Wildfire Regulation.

In addition to open fires being prohibited, the following activities and equipment are also restricted:

- Fireworks;
- Sky Lanterns;
- Burn Barrels or Burn Cages of any size or description;
- Binary Exploding Targets;
- Air curtain burners;
- Tiki and similar kind of torches; and,
- Chimineas.

This prohibition does not include the use of outdoor stoves. As per the Wildfire Regulation, an outdoor stove is a CSA-rated or ULC-rated device used outdoors for cooking, heat or ambiance that burns charcoal briquettes, liquid fuel or gaseous fuel, and has a flame height that is less than 15 cm tall.

Any lot found to be in contravention to this safety ban, will be subject to Cedars Bylaw fines as well as provincial fines.

Septic Usage

We continue to have repair and service costs for blocked septic systems caused by shareholders or renters dumping or flushing items that do not break down and clog pipes and burn out pumps. This last issue looks like it was caused by baby wipes. Please learn what can be flushed and help us reduce user caused problems.

DO FLUSH
The following can be flushed down the toilet.


Toilet paper

DO NOT FLUSH
The following cannot go in the toilet as they can clog pipes and septic systems.

 Paper towels	 Cigarette butts	 Disposable diapers	 Wipes (Baby or flushable)	 Feminine hygiene products
 Plastics	 Medications	 Cotton (Cotton swabs or balls)	 Dental floss	 Toxic Substances

Dispose these items in the trash.

Mosquito Spray

Jason has sprayed roadsides and common areas with garlic spray. Shareholders are responsible for mosquito control on their lots. Garlic spray is available at Canadian Tire.
